



I. Spiritual awakening in our nation

A. Conviction of sin

1. *"And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment."* (John 16:8, NLT)
2. *"Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God."* (2 Corinthians 4:4, NLT)
3. *"Wake up, wake up, O Zion! Clothe yourself with strength. Put on your beautiful clothes, O holy city of Jerusalem, for unclean and godless people will enter your gates no longer."* (Isaiah 52:1, NLT)
4. *"This is all the more urgent, for you know how late it is; time is running out. Wake up, for our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed."* (Romans 13:11, NLT)

B. Revelation of Jesus

1. *"that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him"* (Eph 1:17 NKJV)
2. *"Where there is no revelation, the people cast off restraint; But happy is he who keeps the law."* (Proverbs 29:18, NKJV)
3. *"Jesus told him, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.'"* (John 14:6, NLT)

C. Return to your first love

1. *"Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love. Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent."* (Revelation 2:4-5, NKJV)
2. *"The Lord says, 'Then I will heal you of your faithlessness; my love will know no bounds, for my anger will be gone forever.'"* (Hosea 14:4, NLT)

I. The Government of Jesus (Returning to the Foundation Principles)

- A. *Jesus said, "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place."* (John 18:36 NIV)



- B. *"For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this."* (Isaiah 9:6-7,NIV)
- C. *"For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit"* (Romans 14:17 NIV)
- D. *"Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom."* (Psalm 45:6 NIV)
- E. *"I will place on his shoulder the key to the house of David; what he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open."* (Isaiah 22:22 NIV)
- F. *"For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; it is he who will save us."* (Isaiah 33:22 NIV)
- G. *You are always righteous, LORD, when I bring a case before you. Yet I would speak with you about your justice:Why does the way of the wicked prosper? Why do all the faithless live at ease? (Jeremiah 12:1 NIV)*

MyHOP Prayer Protocol:

- Support the prayer time by focusing on the Lord.
- Speak directly into the mic with a strong voice.
- Stick to the theme established by the prayer leader.
- Read a short scripture passage and pray short, to the point prayers.
- Keep your emphasis on a single thought or phrase.
- Pray, don't preach, teach, sing or prophesy.
- Allow worship leader/singers time to respond.
- The prayer leader will let you know when you may begin reading your scripture.
