



I. Healing Revival in Brevard County

A. Exalt Jesus the Healer

1. (Mt 4:23) And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.
2. (Mt 9:35) Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.
3. (Mt 12:15) But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.
4. (Mt 14:14) And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.
5. (Mt 15:30) Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them.
6. (Ac 10:38) "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

B. Manifest the Promise of Healing

1. (Ps 103:2-3) Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,
2. (Ps 107:20) He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.
3. (Isa 53:5) But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.
4. (Mal 4:2) But to you who fear My name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings;
5. (Mt 10:1) And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.
6. (Mk 16:17-18) "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

7. (Lk 9:1-2) Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
8. (Lk 10:9) And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'
9. (Ac 4:29-30) "Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus."
10. (Mk 9:23) Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."
11. (Jn 11:40) Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?"

MyHOP Prayer Protocol:

- Support the prayer time by focusing on the Lord.
- Speak directly into the mic with a strong voice.
- Stick to the theme established by the prayer leader.
- Read a short scripture passage and pray short, to the point prayers.
- Keep your emphasis on a single thought or phrase.
- Pray, don't preach, teach, sing or prophesy.
- Allow worship leader/singers time to respond.
- The prayer leader will let you know when you may begin reading your scripture.
