



## **I. Pray for Young Men and Women in the Midst of an Increasingly Worldly Culture.**

### **A. for Revival, an outpouring of His Spirit**

(Ac 2:17-18) And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, that I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions, your old men shall dream dreams. And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; and they shall prophesy.

### **B. for a Revelation of their Purpose**

(Ep 2:10) For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

### **C. for Courage and Strength**

(1Jn 2:14) I have written to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the wicked one.

### **D. for Holiness**

(2Ti 2:22) Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

(Tit 2:6-8) Likewise, exhort the young men to be sober-minded, in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you.

### **E. for Leaders from their Generation**

(1Ti 4:12) Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

### **F. for Humility**

(Phl 2:3) Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.

(Mt 23:11-12) But he who is greatest among you shall be your servant. And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.
