



1. Unity among the churches in our region

Brevard County is called to model unusual unity. Recognition of our connection through Christ.

- A. Psalm 133:1-3 (NASB95) ¹Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brothers to dwell together in unity! ²It is like the precious oil upon the head, Coming down upon the beard, Even Aaron's beard, Coming down upon the edge of his robes. ³It is like the dew of Hermon Coming down upon the mountains of Zion; For there the Lord commanded the blessing—life forever.
- B. Romans 12:5 (NASB95) ⁵so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.
- C. Ephesians 4:3-4 (NASB95) ³being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling;
- D. Ephesians 4:13 (NASB95) ¹³until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.
- E. John 17:22-23 (NASB95) ²²"The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one; ²³I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as You have loved Me.
- F. Galatians 3:28 (NASB95) ²⁸There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- G. Philippians 2:2 (NASB95) ²make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.
- H. 1 Corinthians 12:12-13 (NASB95) ¹²For even as the body is one and yet has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ. ¹³For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

2. Righteousness in our cities

Elimination of crime. Return to moral absolutes.

- A. Acts 3:19 (NASB95) ¹⁹"Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord;
- B. Proverbs 14:34 (NASB95) ³⁴Righteousness exalts a nation, But sin is a disgrace to any people.
- C. Hebrews 12:11 (NASB95) ¹¹All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.
- D. 1 Corinthians 15:34 (NASB95) ³⁴Become sober-minded as you ought, and stop sinning; for some have no knowledge of God. I speak this to your shame.
