



I. Spiritual awakening in our nation

A. Conviction of sin

1. *“And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God’s righteousness, and of the coming judgment.”* (John 16:8, NLT)
2. *“Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don’t believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don’t understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God.”* (2 Corinthians 4:4, NLT)
3. *“Wake up, wake up, O Zion! Clothe yourself with strength. Put on your beautiful clothes, O holy city of Jerusalem, for unclean and godless people will enter your gates no longer.”* (Isaiah 52:1, NLT)
4. *“This is all the more urgent, for you know how late it is; time is running out. Wake up, for our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed.”* (Romans 13:11, NLT)

B. Revelation of Jesus

1. *“that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him”* (Eph 1:17 NKJV)
2. *“Where there is no revelation, the people cast off restraint; But happy is he who keeps the law.”* (Proverbs 29:18, NKJV)
3. *“Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.”* (John 14:6, NLT)

C. Return to your first love

1. *“Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love. Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent.”* (Revelation 2:4–5, NKJV)
2. *“The Lord says, “Then I will heal you of your faithlessness; my love will know no bounds, for my anger will be gone forever.”* (Hosea 14:4, NLT)

II. Families

A. Strong marriages

1. *“For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her”* (Ephesians 5:25, NLT)
2. *“So again I say, each man must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.”* (Ephesians 5:33, NLT)
3. *“This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one.”* (Genesis 2:24, NLT)

B. Prodigal children

1. *“I will go home to my father and say, “Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you,”* (Luke 15:18, NLT)
2. *“Those who have been ransomed by the Lord will return. They will enter Jerusalem singing, crowned with everlasting joy. Sorrow and mourning will disappear, and they will be filled with joy and gladness.”* (Isaiah 51:11, NLT)
