



I. Protection of Florida Coastlines from hurricanes and natural calamities- June 1 marked the beginning of the hurricane season.

A. City of refuge: Melbourne, the Harbor City

1. Psalm 91:2 (NASB95) I will say to the Lord, “My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust!”
2. Psalm 91:11 (NASB95) For He will give His angels charge concerning you, To guard you in all your ways.
3. Psalm 103:20 (NASB95) Bless the Lord, you His angels, Mighty in strength, who perform His word, Obeying the voice of His word!
4. Hebrews 1:14 (NASB95) Are they not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?

B. Faith to Believe- don't look at wind and waves

1. Mark 4:39 (NASB95) And He got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, “Hush, be still.” And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm.
2. Matthew 14:25 (NASB95) And in the fourth watch of the night He came to them, walking on the sea.
3. Matthew 14:30 (NASB95) But seeing the wind, he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, “Lord, save me!”
4. Psalm 107:28–31 (NASB95) Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, And He brought them out of their distresses. He caused the storm to be still, So that the waves of the sea were hushed. Then they were glad because they were quiet, So He guided them to their desired haven. Let them give thanks to the Lord for His lovingkindness, And for His wonders to the sons of men!

C. Bind Fear and doubt created by media hype

1. 2 Timothy 1:7 (NASB95) For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.

II. Bold proclamation of truth

A. Expose deception

1. Ephesians 5:11–12 (NASB95) Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them; for it is disgraceful even to speak of the things which are done by them in secret.
2. Psalm 43:3 (NASB95) O send out Your light and Your truth, let them lead me; Let them bring me to Your holy hill And to Your dwelling places.
3. Ephesians 4:14–15 (NASB95) As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming; but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ,
4. 1 Timothy 2:3–4 (NASB95) This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.
